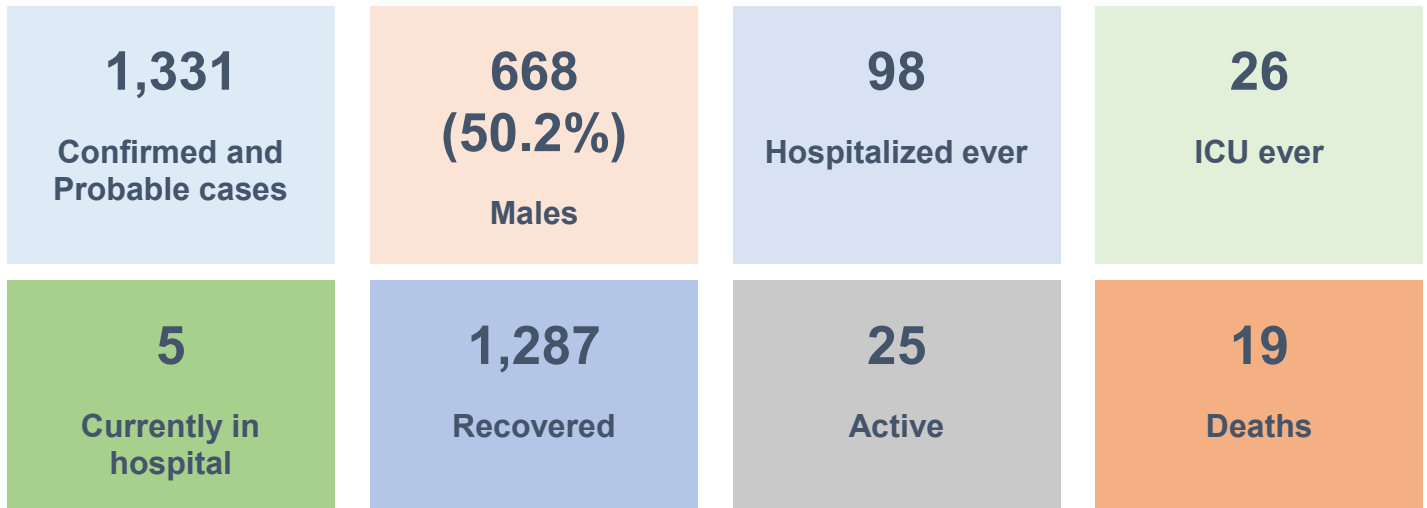


# COVID-19 Cases in Blackfoot Confederacy (BFC) Tribal Council, Alberta

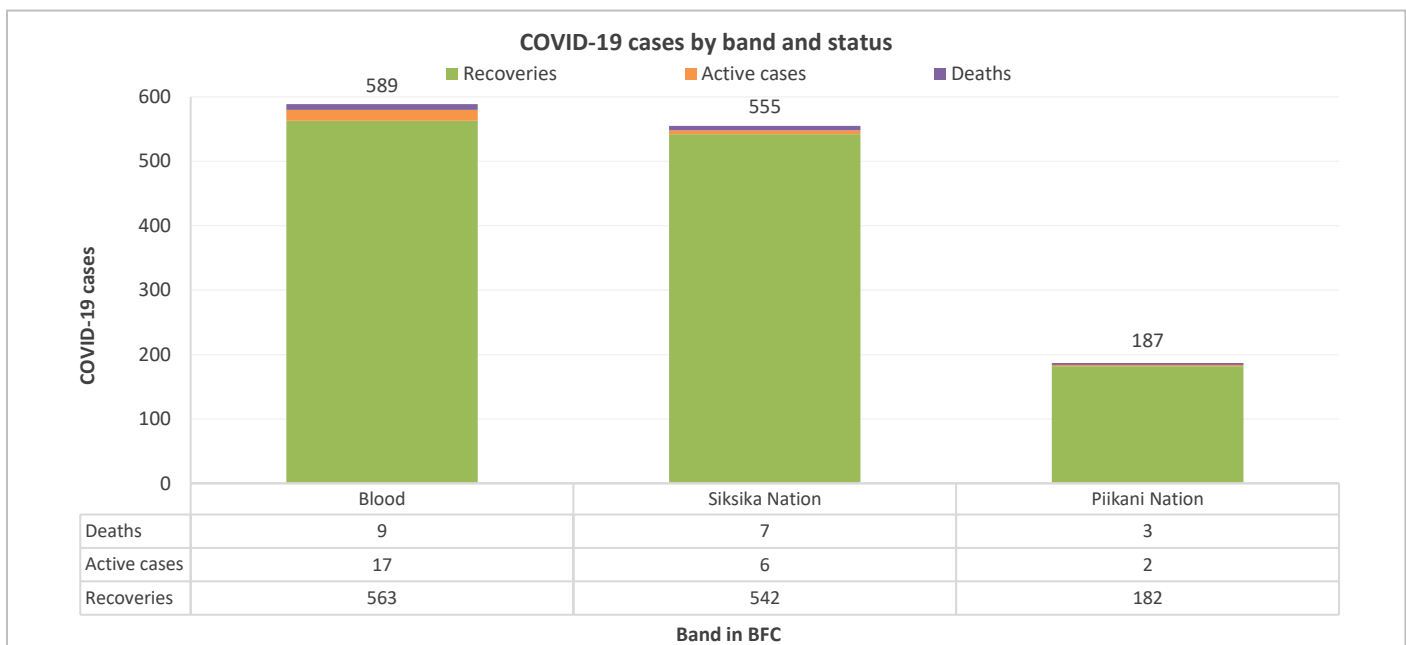

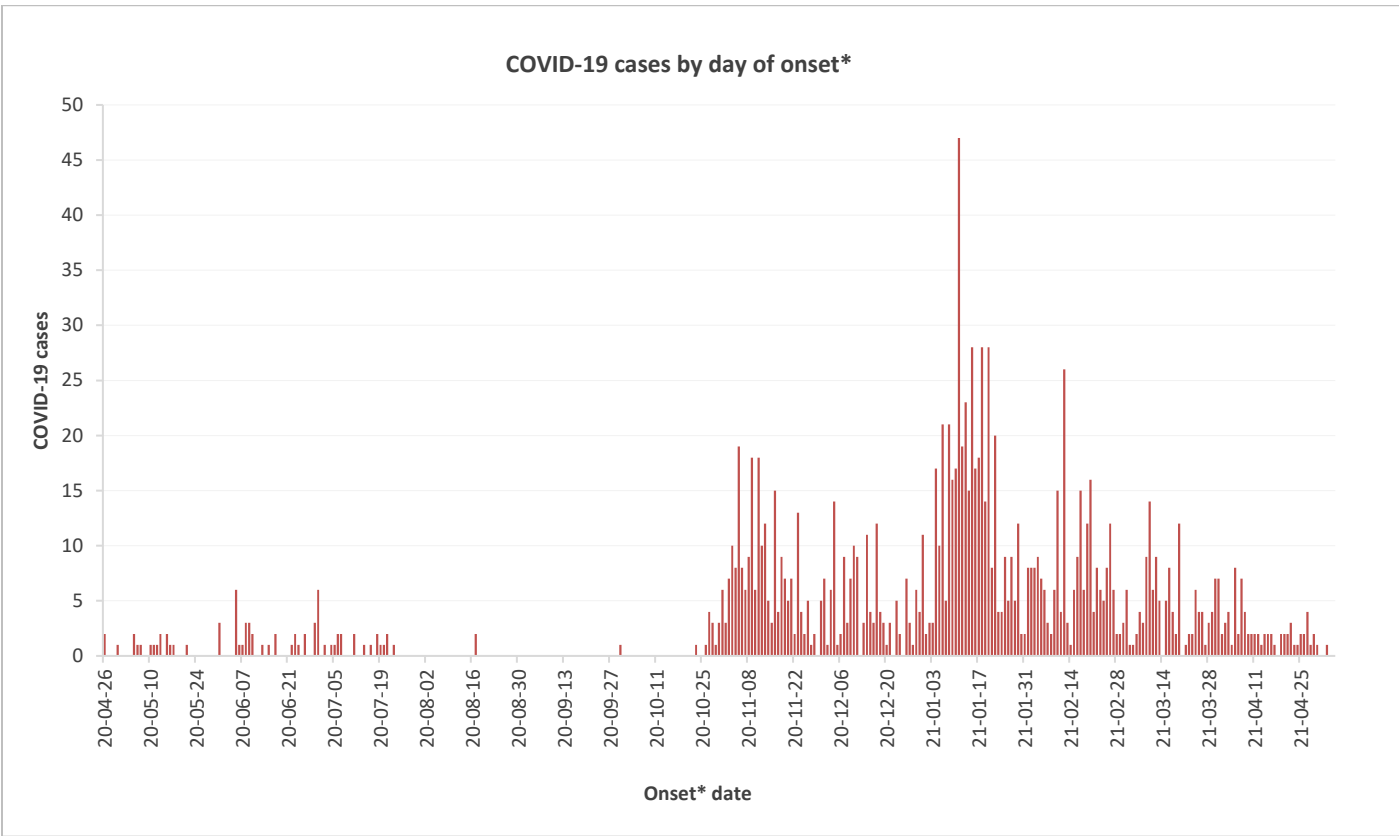
## Highlights



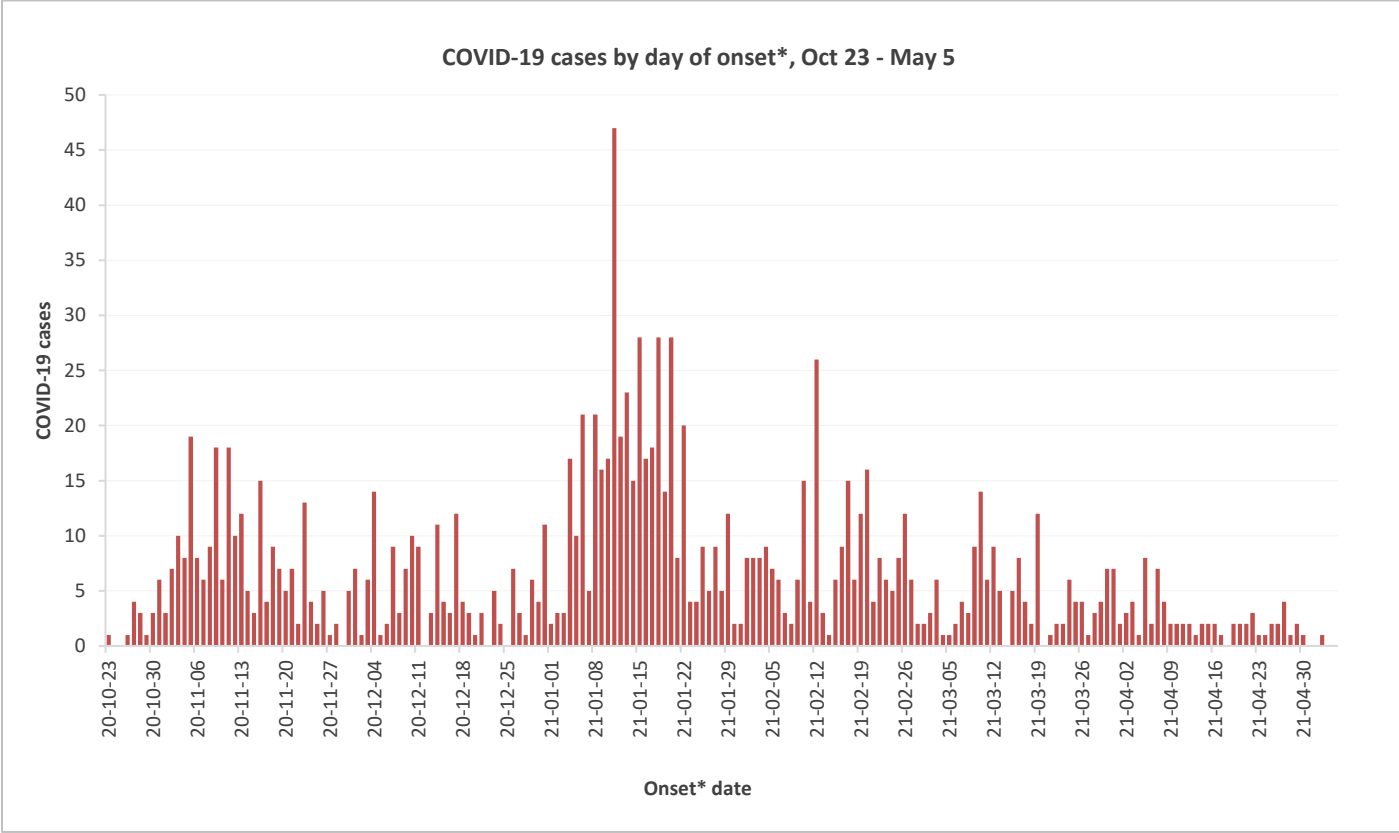
There have been a total of 47 Variant of Concern (VOC) cases in BFC communities with 10 VOC cases that are currently active.

NOTE: FNIHB-AB uses Alberta Health surveillance definition of active and recovered cases. The surveillance definition of active and recovered cases is used to try and understand the number of active cases in the population and it is not related to clinical management of cases. A confirmed case is assumed to be recovered 14 days after the specimen collection date. A probable case is assumed to be recovered 14 days after the date the case was reported to FNIHB-AB. A hospitalized case is assumed to be recovered when their symptoms have resolved based on case follow-up, or 10 days after being discharged from hospital.

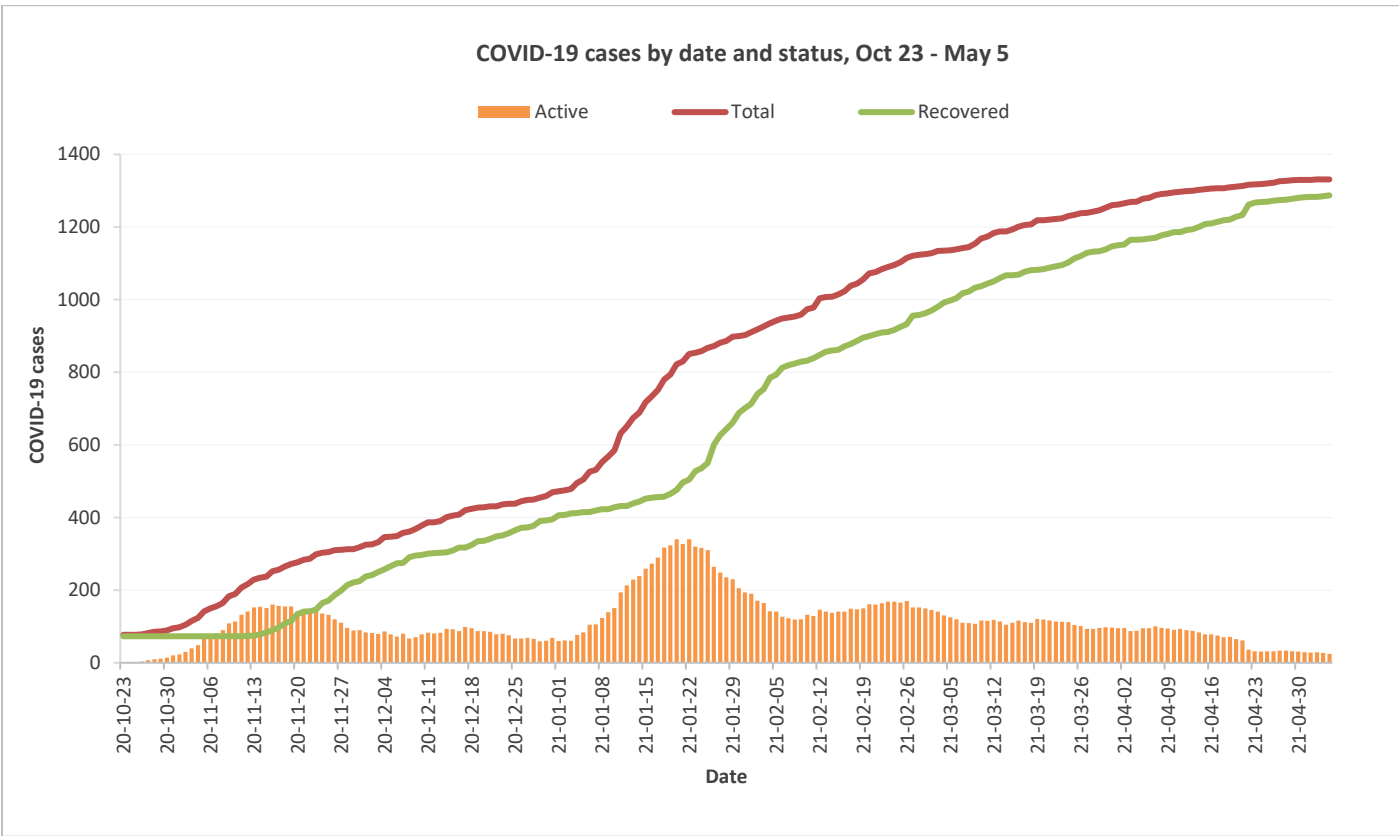




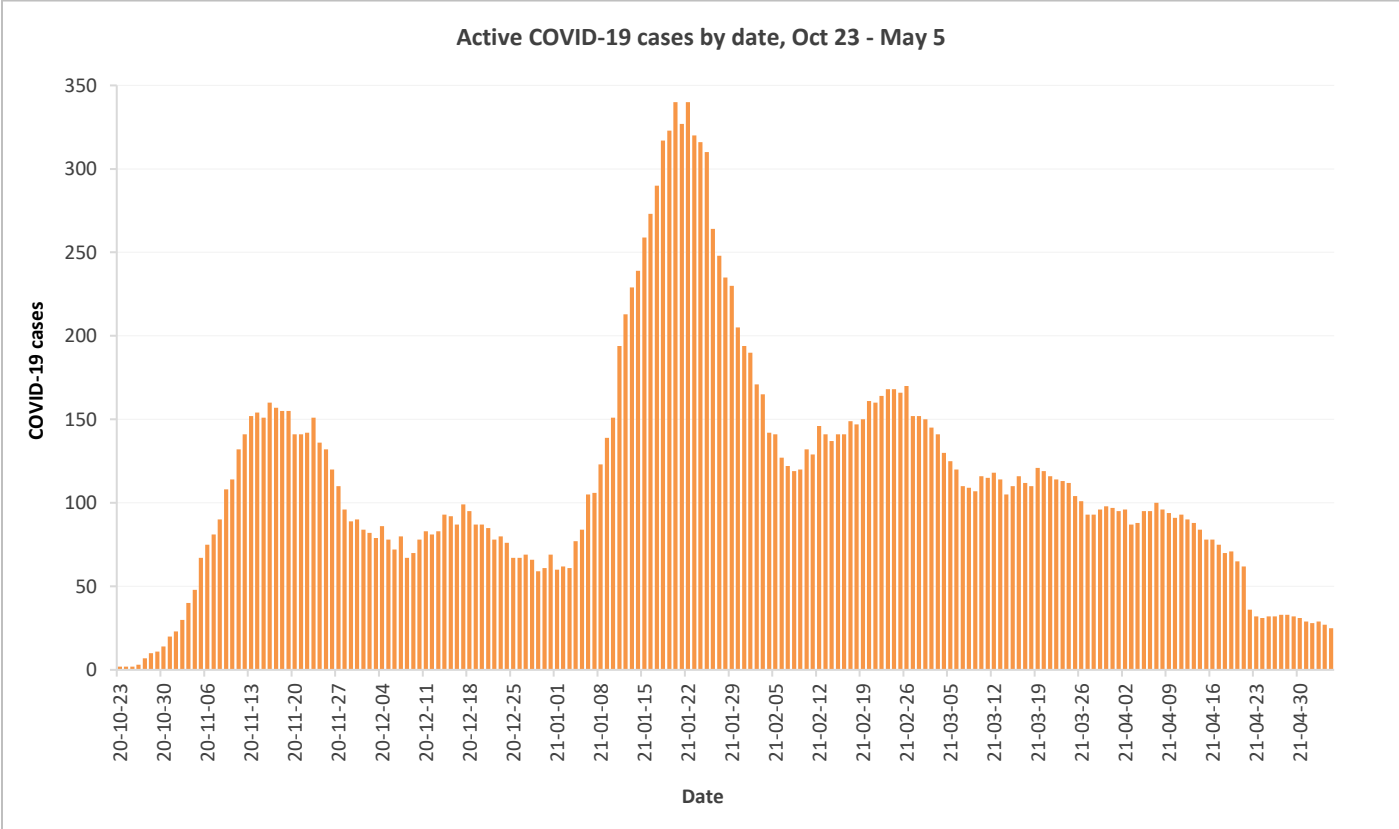
