#### **Purpose:**

The Assembly of Treaty Chiefs (AOTC) 2021 was convened to discuss reforms and enhance the working relationship among Treaty 6, 7, and 8 Nations in Alberta. Established in 2004, the AOTC provides a platform for Treaty Chiefs to deliberate on issues related to Inherent and Treaty Rights, lands, traditional territories, and the impacts of decisions made by the GoC and GoA governments.

The Chiefs signed the <u>Unity Declaration</u>, agreeing not to incorporate but to seek support from Confederacy of Treaty organizations for funding, coordination, and follow-up directives. The assembly in April 2025 will include ceremonial openings, leadership perspectives, updates on major issues, challenges in strategic plans, and discussions on reforms for equitable representation and communication."
